

Developing in Old Town Lewisville

As interest in Old Town development began to increase, City planners saw the need for a unique development code specific to Old Town. In 2003, the Lewisville City Council passed the Old Town Development Ordinance. The document seeks to preserve the architectural character of Old Town, allow more flexibility with regard to development and encourage mixed-use developments. The Old Town Development Ordinance created a citizen board made up of Old Town stakeholders that review architectural plans for new construction or alterations for existing buildings as well as sign design.
